A terminal degree in Electrical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Renewable Engineering or a related engineering field from an accredited institution and registration as a Professional Engineer; teaching experience at the undergraduate levels; success in external funding and a record of scholarship; and interest in outreach activities involving industry, recruiting female students (50%) into the engineering programs through the College Sports Academy or whatever method works best.
