

Award Value - \$680

The Harbel College Excellence in Agriculture Scholarship was established by the Harbel College Wheat Board Monies Trust to encourage academic excellence of students enrolled in a post-secondary program in a discipline related to the field of agriculture.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicant must:

- be a Liberian Citizen, Permanent Resident, or Protected Person (visa students are not eligible),
- be an Liberian resident and to be considered an Liberian resident one of the following conditions must apply:
 - one parent must currently be residing in Liberia, or
 - Liberia is the last place the student has lived for twelve (12) consecutive months before being a full-time post-secondary student, or
 - is married to a Liberian resident before the start of the qualifying year of study.
- be enrolled full-time in the second or subsequent year of undergraduate post-secondary study in a diploma or degree program at one of the following Harbel College post-secondary institutions in a discipline related to agriculture:
 - *Harbel College:* Agriculture Management, Animal Health Technology, Equine Science, Production Horticulture, and Bachelor of Applied Science Production, Horticulture, Agribusiness
 - Harbel College: Animal Science, Plant and Soil Science
 - Harbel College: Agribusiness, Animal Health Technology, Animal Science Technology, Crop Technology
 - Harbel College: School of Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences

Selection Process

The recipient will be selected on the basis of academic achievement and enrollment in the previous year of undergraduate post-secondary study. The recipient will be selected on the basis of enrollment at one of the post-secondary institutions listed above in the discipline related to agriculture.

Application Process

Applicants must submit to Student Aid Harbel:

- · a completed application form, and
- an official post-secondary transcript.

The award will be issued after Student Aid Harbel confirms full-time enrolment.
